

# Pharmacy Service Summary Nova Scotia, Canada



### **Assessment and Prescribing**

#### **Initiate Therapy**

- Contraception Management FE
- Herpes Zoster Treatment FE
- Inhaled Steroid for COVID-19 FE
- Invasive Bacterial Disease Chemoprophylaxis in Collaboration with Public Health – FE
- Lyme Disease Chemoprophylaxis FE
- Minor Ailments Prescribing FC
- Ear/Nose/Throat (Otitis Media/Externa, Sinusitis, Pharyngitis) – FAC
- Uncomplicated Cystitis FE

#### **Extend/Modify Existing Therapy**

- Extend ANY existing prescription (Renewals) for up to one year – FE
- Modify ANY existing therapy (Adapt dose, duration, frequency (e.g. drug dosing in renal impairment, pediatric dose adjustments))\* – FE
- Modify ANY existing therapy (Substitution (e.g. allergy, shortage, drug interaction))\* – FE
- Deprescribing FAC

\* Modification also applies for chronic medications if the patient was not achieving treatment goals (e.g. adjust dose of HTN medication) or experiencing adverse reactions (switch therapy).

## **Drug Administration**

- COVID-19 Vaccine FE
- Influenza Vaccine FE
- Higher risk Meningitis FE
- Publicly Funded Vaccines
  (e.g. pneumococcal, Tdap) FAC
- Remaining Non-Publicly Funded Vaccine FS
- Anti-psychotics FAC
- Other medication (e.g. contraception, B12) FS

Nova Scotia has **REGULATED TECHNICIANS** that take legal responsibility for the technical aspects of checking prescriptions, administering drugs/vaccines and conducting point-of-care testing.

FE – Publicly Funded Everywhere, AE – Available Everywhere
 FC – Publicly Funded in Designated Clinics, Fee for Service Elsewhere,
 FAC – Funded/Available in Designated Clinics/Pharmacies Only,

**FS** – Fee for Service Everywhere, **AC** – Available in Designated Clinics

- Initiate/Modify therapy for any disease with a collaborative prescribing agreement with another healthcare provider – FS (except adaption/substitution – FE)
- INR POCT and Warfarin Adaptation FE
- Mental Health Support Program FAC
- Tobacco Cessation FC

- Advanced Medication Review FE
- Basic Medication Review FE
- Medication Review Follow-Up FE

### Testing

- POCT Lipid FAC
- POCT A1C FAC
- INR Testing FE
- Strep Throat PCR Testing FAC
- Access labs from provincial lab database AE
- Order labs AC
