# **Sharps Waste Handling Procedure**





### What is acceptable Sharps Waste?

#### **Acceptable**

- ✓ Used Needles
- ✓ Used Syringes
- ✓ Used Lancets or Fingerstick Devices
- ✓ Used Pen Needles
- ✓ Used single dose auto injectors that contain a needle
- ✓ Used infusion sets Connect Set Needles

#### Not Acceptable

- X Medications & pill bottles
- X PPE (Gloves, Gowns, Masks)
- X Garbage, Recycling & Packaging
- X Band aids, Tissues & Biomedical Waste
- X Any waste from LTC facilities, Physicians or other commercial enterprises
- X Pens without sharps or other retractable sharps
- X Devices, like insulin pens with self-retracting needle
- X Drum Lancets



## Collection Containers, Overpacking for Transport, Labelling & Storage

Primary Collection Containers (pictured to the left) must be yellow, leak-proof, sealed and puncture resistant.

- When overpacking for transport, place a sharps container in a lined, reusable container or cardboard box. Liner must be yellow and securely tied. Tape box flaps closed.
- Store in a secure & controlled area of pharmacy. (Refrigeration not required)
